I am very excited to start making music and learning with you. This contract is to clarify some details and make sure that everybody knows what to expect in this learning journey. Lessons will happen once a week, unless an otherwise mutually agreed on schedule is created by the teacher and the student's parent. Payments for the entire month-worth of lessons should be made within the first week of the month of the lessons being paid for. Acceptable forms of payment include cash, check, Venmo, or Zelle. Checks may be made out to Lindsey Wiehl and mailed to the address listed at the top of the page. For in-person lessons, it is recommended that the student arrive approximately 5 minutes before the lesson's official start time to get settled and organize their materials. The teacher reserves the right to cancel the lesson if the student is more than 10 minutes late for a 30-minute lesson or more than 15 minutes late for a 50-minute lesson. Please let me know if you are unfamiliar with the technology for zoom meetings, and I will do my best to help! Students must notify the teacher of any cancellations within the previous 24- hours of the lesson via email or phone. If given 24-hour notice, the teacher will give opportunities to make up the cancelled lesson. Students are guaranteed 3 make up lessons per "semester" (Semesters run from July 1 to December 31, and then from January 1 to June 31). Should a student miss more than 3 lessons, (either due to cancellations/missed lessons per semester), then additional make up lessons are at the teacher's discretion. Refunds will not be given for the lessons the student cancels or misses without reasonable notice. If the teacher misses or cancels a lesson, they will be responsible for finding time to reschedule the lesson. If you are taking in-person lessons and your school is closed due to inclement weather, the lessons on that day will be canceled and rescheduled at a mutually agreed upon time (or may be joined online if the student and parent choose). The student's parent/guardian should discuss other school breaks with the teacher ahead of time, preferably before the month's payment is made at the beginning of the month. Lesson rates for 2023-2024 school year are as follows: \$50.00 per lesson for 50-minute lessons \$30.00 per lesson for 25-minute lessons Students should have regular access to an instrument and necessary accessories (seat strap, reed(s), music or lesson book, swab, pencil). The student will be given weekly practice goals based on the age and level of the student. Reeds may be purchased at a local music store. I also sell handmade bassoon reeds for \$20 (plus \$4 per order if shipped). If help is needed to secure an instrument, please contact the teacher or your school music teacher.
